On August 29, 1966, Sayyid Qutb was sent to the gallows by the Nasser regime of Egypt. The specific charge against him was based on his now-celebrated book, Maʿālim fī al-Ṭarīq (Milestones), which denounces the existing order in Muslim societies. Sayyid Qutb's other works have been translated into virtually every language that Muslims read, and remain hugely influential. But it was Fī Zilāl al-Qurʾān (In the Shade of the Qurʾan), the multi-volume tafsīr of the Qurʾan which he wrote during his long confinements in prison, to which he owes his fame.
