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IN THIS ISSUE

In the opening article John W. Jandora, of Palatine, Illinois, discusses various aspects of the career of Buṭrus al-Bustānī, his attitude to the Ottoman regime, and especially his effort “to instill a sense of Arab consciousness and with it a sense of common purpose in the Syrian public,” working towards a closer cooperation between various segments of the country’s population for the sake of Arab cultural revival.

Sūra 2:228 and its varying interpretations, particularly regarding divorce and women’s rights, are the subject matter of the second article, by M. Hashim Kamali (Research Associate, Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada, Ottawa). Some classical and modern commentators are quoted, and reference is made to reforms introduced by the Syrian Law of Personal Status of 1953, and, also in the 50s, the novel interpretations of S. 4:35 given by the High Court of Lahore and the reform of the laws of divorce in the Tunisian Law of Personal Status.

Dr. James F. Goode, lecturer in the Department of History, University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia, deals in the closing article with the first United States mission to Iran in the 1880s, describing the short diplomatic career of Samuel Greene Wheeler Benjamin in Tehran, and pointing out, as one of the ironies of history, “that religious considerations inspired the establishment of diplomatic relations between the United States and Iran in 1883, and eventually contributed to the severing of relations a century later.”
